The City of Memphis, in coordination with the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT), and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing to extend Paul R. Lowry Road from its current terminus at the south end of the Port of Memphis' Frank C. Pidgeon Industrial Park to Weaver Road or State Route (SR) 14 (US-61/South Third Street) in Shelby County, Tennessee. The proposed project is sponsored by the City of Memphis, the Economic Development Growth Engine for Memphis and Shelby County (EDGE) and the International Port of Memphis. This public meeting is being held as part of the NEPA process, and an Environmental Assessment (EA) is currently being developed. Paul R. Lowry Road, in the project area, is currently a two-lane facility (one travel lane in each direction) with 11-foot travel lanes and two-foot shoulders that terminates in the southeastern section of the Frank C. Pidgeon Industrial Park, just west of the Horn Lake Cutoff.

The public meeting will provide the public with the opportunity to review and comment on the purpose and need for the proposed Paul R. Lowry Road extension project as well as the range of alternatives under consideration. Project displays will be available to [view](#) and the City of Memphis and TDOT project team members will be available to answer questions.
